OFFICE MEMORANDUM

In line with revision of Guidelines by CGHS for treatment in Naturopathy at Babu Nature Cure Hospital & Yogashram, New Delhi, following revised guidelines shall be applicable for DGEHS beneficiaries -

- 1) For inpatient treatment the package rates as prescribed in OM No. F.Z-28015/01/2006-HDCell/CGHS (P) dated 01.01.2008 shall be applicable as all inclusive. No unlisted treatment procedures would be permitted / reimbursed.
- 2) OPD treatment shall be permitted as per actual subject to the ceiling rate of Rs. 500/- per day, irrespective of the number and modalities of treatment procedures performed.
- 3) Permission to the DGEHS beneficiaries for availing OPD treatment shall be granted for up to 15 days at a time and it may be extended if required, for a further period of two fortnights. Permission for OPD treatment beyond 45 days may be granted by the Director Health Services in consultation with Department of AYUSH.
- 4) Permission for inpatient treatment shall be granted for up to 30 days at a time and it may be extended if required, for a further period of 30 days. Permission for inpatient treatment beyond 60 days may be granted by Director Health Services in consultation with Department of AYUSH.


