

Sub- Schedule of activities regarding "SWATCH BHARAT ABHIYAN" for the week from 26<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October with a grand function on 2<sup>nd</sup> October and the continuance of the programme for the four weeks of October.

The schedule of the SWATCH BHARAT ABHIYAN programs organized for the week starting from 25<sup>th</sup> September 2014 to 1<sup>st</sup> October are given below. This week would be dedicated to creating awareness through various activities like workshops, competitions, installation of various boards pertaining to cleanliness and cleaning of the total campus.

#### 25<sup>th</sup> September

1. A meeting for planning the activities was held and the course of action was decided.
2. Installing of **USE NO PLASTIC** and **DO NOT LITTER**, **USE DUSTBIN**, and **SWATCH BHARAT ABHIYAN** boards on Campus. The activity was undertaken and temporary boards were installed which would be replaced with permanent boards on Monday, 28<sup>th</sup> September.

#### 26<sup>th</sup> September

1. Cleaning of Toilets and Campus.
2. Activity was undertaken and the toilets and other premises of the college were cleaned and duty charts pasted on all toilets for regularising the cleaning and maintenance of toilets.

#### 29<sup>th</sup> September

2. There will be a competition for the students where they will make presentation of the need for cleanliness.
3. Total Cleaning of Classrooms, labs, and offices will be undertaken as an inter- departmental competition involving MAE, CSE, ECE, Humanities and Administration/Accounts departments. The best department in terms of cleanliness would be judged and given prizes.

#### 30<sup>th</sup> September

2<sup>nd</sup> October the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi would be celebrated in an elaborate manner with various programs envisaged under the aegis of the **SWATCH BHARAT PROGRAM** envisioned by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. The detailed program for the day is given below.

**A) Week starting from 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 to 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2014.**

1. The NSS volunteers of the college would be undertaking various programs for creating awareness in the campus about cleanliness.
2. There would be street plays and pamphlet distribution by the volunteers on the theme of cleanliness and the need for a SWATCH BHARAT programme.
